Project: Restoration of the existing Coachman's House, New build infill of court yard and state of the art Hi-Tec fit out

Project Length: 18 months

Information: Restoration Projects undertook the complicated design and build projects from its conception sympathetically connecting the 19th century hall to the Coachman's House with a steel framed building, a traditional brick and stone facade rebuilt chimney and a traditional roofing.

The Hi-Tec interior will include 2 cinemas, night club / games room, panic room, bedrooms and bathrooms. Air conditioning with climate control, Lutron.... State of the art security system.

Restoration Projects worked along side Architects Tim and Peter (Core designs) and interior designer David Murray (Murray Creative Interior) and Engineer Jane Entwistle (Thomasons) to add a stunning addition to this imposing hall, aesthetically pleasing with an ultra modern interior.

Our works included:

- New build structural steel frame with traditional brick and stone link building
- Structural steel supporting to the Coachman's House re roofing in stone roofing, and rebuild chimneys
- High specification fit out of bathrooms, cinema, lounge and bedrooms
- Under floor heating system and air conditioning throughout the property.
